

RECREATION COMMISSION PARK TOUR

JULY 13, 2016 AT 6PM

Minutes – Motion made by Commissioner Manfra to approve the May 11, 2016, seconded by Commissioner Moscone, all in favor by voice vote.

Vouchers –

Motion made by Commissioner Manfra to approve the May 2016 vouchers, seconded by Commissioner Moscone, all in favor by voice vote.

Motion made by Commissioner Manfra to approve the June 2016 vouchers, seconded by Commissioner Moscone, all in favor by voice vote.

Commissioner Manfra questioned what the check for \$13,000 for basketball was for. Director Dent stated she was directed to pay the Board of Education the \$13,000 for use of the schools for the in town basketball program.

Masar Park – Fencing needs to be installed around the skate rink. The benches also need to be anchored into the concrete. Liaison Armelino would like to approval to get a storage container at the facility. Director Dent received a quote in 2015 between \$195,000 - \$215,000 for new lighting at Masar which includes all new poles and getting the lights put onto the electronic scheduling system.

Camp Dawson – There was damage to the netting that is between the parking lot and fields which needs to be addressed. The possibility of installing cameras at Dawson in the future through grant monies was discussed.

Reilly Field – Additional clay was requested, Director Dent noted this field was used by Men's softball Leagues who are responsible for their own grooming. The amount of clay placed on this field is dependent upon what is in the DPW budget for this line. Director Dent also noted that any issues with the field are always directly communicated between the field users and herself and addressed upon request. The field is groomed occasionally by DPW for field rentals if there is a safety issue such as a divot, etc.

Community Park – Playmedics has assessed the playground and will be sending a quote to outline the repair cost if we were to go through them for all the repairs needed. New cement pads were laid on around the pavilion to make the area handicapped accessible.
