RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF HEALTH OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MONTVILLE, COUNTY OF MORRIS AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY STRONGLY RECOMMENDING THAT ALL MONTVILLE TOWNSHIP RESIDENTS COOPERATE WITH COVID-19 CONTACT TRACING EFFORTS

WHEREAS, the Montville Township Board of Health recognizes that contact tracing is an effective disease control strategy that involves identifying cases and their contacts then working with them to interrupt disease transmission; and

WHEREAS, contact tracing is a key strategy to prevent the further spread of COVID-19;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township of Montville Board of Health, in the County of Morris, and State of New Jersey strongly recommends that any and all Montville Township residents participate in contact tracing efforts and cooperate with communicable disease investigators conducting contact tracing efforts.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
