MONTVILLE TOWNSHIP CLEAN COMMUNITY LEADERSHIP SUPERVISOR AGREEMENT FOR CLEAN UPS

Our Clean Communities Cleanup program may resume as of April 17th. All participants may resume volunteer cleanups, provided COVID-19 guidelines established by the Governor's Office are strictly followed and enforced. Each organization must assign a Supervisor to ensure that the COVID-19 guidelines listed below are followed and enforced for each clean up.

NJCCC COVID-19 Guidelines:

- Volunteers must wear masks.
- Volunteers must wear gloves while picking up trash.
- Groups of volunteers cleaning in one location must be **limited to 10.**
- Volunteers must social-distance.
- Cleanups must be supervised to ensure that COVID-19 guidelines are followed and enforced.
- Masks, gloves and hand sanitizer will be provided for all volunteer participants. Clean Communities grant funds may be used for this purpose.
